Dr Lim Hui Ling has practiced at IMC since 2002 and is the Medical Director of IMC, based at the Jelita Clinic. A graduate of the National University of Singapore in 1993. Dr Lim was awarded her Masters in Family Medicine in 1999. She is the Honorary Assistant Secretary of the College of Family Physicians and also sits on various Ministry of Health Committees. She was also a tutor and examiner in the Graduate Diploma in Family Medicine Programme since its inception. During her training, she rotated through various hospital and primary care departments from paediatrics to geriatrics, surgery and ENT to mental health.

Dr Wang Junjie is the Head and Consultant of the Department of Gynaecological Oncology, KK Women's and Children's Hospital. Dr Wang underwent overseas training in the Inselspital in Bern, Switzerland and Oscar Lambret Cancer Centre in Lille, France. His fellowship training had a strong focus on advanced laparoscopic surgery for gynaecological cancers.

Dr Wang is passionate about prevention of gynaecological cancers and ensuring cancer patients get optimal treatment. He is committed to the well-being and comfort of cancer patients. He is also passionate about minimally invasive gynaecological surgeries and also deep pelvic surgeries with particular interest in cancer surgery.

Dr Tan Kok Kuan graduated from the National University of Singapore in 2001 and was a resident doctor in the two largest public hospitals in Singapore; Tan Tock Seng Hospital and Singapore General Hospital. As part of the SARS taskforce in SGH, he tended to ill patients with suspected SARS during the outbreak. Dr Tan also worked and trained at the Singapore National Eye Center, National Heart Center and National Skin Center. Apart from that, he set up Robertson Medical Practice and this clinic grew to become the DTAP (Dr Tan & Partners) Group of Clinics and Dr Tan served as the group CEO. He stepped down from this role in 2020 to pursue his true passion on STD/HIV and Men's Health. He was one of the authors for Singapore's National HIV PrEP Guidelines and Singapore's Blueprint to end AIDS and HIV Transmission by 2030.
